The ignition MUST be turned OFF before installation!





1 Remove the seat.

It is best to completely remove the seat from the bike although the install can be performed with the seat in the up position.

- 2 Remove the 4 screws that hold the engine cover in place (Fig.A).
- 3 Remove the engine cover.




4 Unplug the stock wiring harness from each injector (Fig.B).




5 Plug the connectors from the PCIII inline of the stock wiring harness and injectors (Fig.C).

Connect the ORANGE colored wires to the left hand cylinder.




- Locate the RED wire with the YEL-LOW stripe of the Throttle Position Sensor. The TPS is located on the right hand side of the throttle bodies.
- 7 Crimp the supplied wire tap to the RED/YELLOW wire (Fig. D).
- 8 Connect the GREY wire from the PCIII to the wire tap (Fig. D).

It is recommended to use dielectric grease on these connections.



9 Attach the ground wire from the PCIII to the fuel rail mounting bolt (Fig. E).



- 10 Reinstall the engine cover.
- 11 Route the PCIII harness out the left hand side of the cover where the cutaway is located (Fig. F).



- 12 Install the PCIII in the tool kit location (Fig. G).
- Reinstall the seat if it was removed.
