






2 Remove the chrome left hand engine cover below the fuel tank.


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Remove the fuel tank. To remove the fuel line squeeze the orange tabs of the connector and push in (Fig. A).


4 Unplug the three electrical connectors.




5 Remove the battery cover by removing the five screws (Fig. B).



- 6 Lay the PCIII in front of the battery temporarily (Fig. C).
- 7 Attach the black ground lead from the PCIII to the negative side of the battery.




8 Route the PCIII harness towards the front of the bike (Fig. D). Follow the stock wiring harness through the guides.



- 9 Locate the stock 12 pin black connector from the throttle body.
- 10 Unplug this connector (Fig. E).

  There is a tab on the backside of this connector that if you push will allow the connector to be removed from the frame.



Plug the connectors from the PCIII in-line of the stock connector (Fig.F).



- 12 Reinstall the battery cover.
- 13 Slide the PCIII into the supplied protective sleeve.
- Lay the PCIII in front of the battery cover and under the seat bracket (Fig.G).

Note: The picture shows the PCIII without the protective sleeve.

Make sure to use the sleeve to prevent any damage to the unit.

- 15 Reinstall the fuel tank and connect the fuel line and connectors.
- 16 Reinstall the seat. Make sure the PCIII harness will not get damaged.

Note: If you have a European or California model it is recommended to remove the stock O2 sensor and install the Dynojet O2 eliminator part #76423007.
