

- 2. Install the Dynojet needles on groove #3, using all stock spacers (Fig. A). There are no adjusting washers for this kit.
- 3. Remove the main jets and replace with the Dynojet main jets provided. Use the DJ076 main jets with stock exhaust, or use the DJ080 main with aftermarket headers or slip-ons with free flowing baffles. Be sure that the jets you are changing are the main jets.
- 4. Locate the fuel mixture screw (Fig. B). Carefully turn mixture screw clockwise until lightly seated, then back out 2-1/2 turns.
